- We supply fresh, high quality, organically grown vegetable seeds and seedlings from April to September.
- The farm staff is diligent in starting vegetables for seedlings, many of which are heirloom varieties, which *may include but not be limited to* the following: Arugula, Beans, Beets, Broccoli, Pak Choi, Cabbage, Carrots, Cauliflower, Cucumbers, Eggplant, Garlic, Herbs (basil, cilantro, oregano, dill, and parsley), Kale, Leeks, Lettuces, Melons, Mustard Greens, Okra, Onions, Peas, Peppers (sweet & hot of many colors), Radishes, Summer Squash, Spinach, Salad Mix, Tomatoes, Tomatillos, Winter Squash, Zucchini, and, on occasion, Flowers*.

*We try to grow many unique heirloom varieties that are higher risk cultivars.
